# EXAM DIET

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- Runs from Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> April to Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> May.
- Study leave begins on Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> April. Your last day will be Friday 19<sup>th</sup>
- Return to school Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> June
- Be in school uniform at all times



# TIMETABLES

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- Individualised timetables will be issued after the Easter break
- These will include which hall or room you will sit your exam in and your seat number
- This will also have your SCN number on it which you will need for EVERY exam.
- Your SCN number will be on your timetable- and the seating lists.



It is your responsibility to ensure your exams are correct and you are being presented at the correct level.

Ensure you know where and when your exam takes place.

(pupils with additional time- your exam times and exam room will be indicated on your individualised timetable.

It is your responsibility to get the correct room/hall on time



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- You must register with Ms McMillan in the social space 15 minutes before your exam.
  - If you have forgotten your SCN number or card, check the seating lists

- **Check your entry/ exam levels.** If there are any errors, you must tell me on the day you receive your timetable.
- **IF YOU ARE NOT ENTERED FOR AN EXAM, YOU CANNOT SIT IT!**
- You will still receive a paper certificate in addition to the notification service.

# EQUIPMENT

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- Ensure you bring the correct equipment for each exam
- 3 pens (a pencil dependent upon exam)
- Calculator- if relevant
- Ruler- if required
  
- There is an 'emergency box' in the exam hall- however, this is for emergencies. You should not assume the equipment you require will be available.



# ELECTRONIC DEVICES/ DISRUPTING EXAM

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Bags and jackets must be left at the side of each Hall

- No electronic devices
- No Apple/ Smart watches
- No mobile phones
- No hoodies ( sorry S6, but that includes Leaver's hoodies too)
  
- Disruption of exam/ distracting other pupils will result in you being removed from the exam hall. This will be reported to the SQA and you will not receive a result for that exam ( and perhaps all other exams)





# SEATING

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- It is vital that you sit in the correct seat, in the correct hall.
- This is how we register you.
- If you are in the incorrect seat you will be registered as absent
- If you are in someone else's seat, it appears as if they are in- they then are not marked as absent and may not get the opportunity to be given exceptional circumstances for the exam



# ILLNESS/ LATENESS

## IF YOU ARE ILL:

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- Contact school- you must let me know so I can put in an EXCEPTIONAL CIRCUMSTANCES REQUEST
- Medical certificate- I cannot proceed an ECR without it.

## LATE

- Must contact me as soon as possible
- Do not panic!
- Can enter exam hall at Invigilator's discretion ( but this only applies to the first 10 mins) If you are repeatedly late, you will not gain entry e.g. If you keep turning up at 8.59, you won't get in.

# TRANSPORT

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- If your exam finishes before the end of the school day, you may leave the school premises- however, you will not be given a bus pass.
- If your exam finishes after the school day there are two scenarios;
  - i) some buses will be held back
  - ii) you will have to use your YoungScot card.
- ii) Holidays/ in service days- transport will be arranged for you. SPT will contact you directly in relation to this. Update will be on the school website (SQA Section)

If you have an exam on an in-service day or holiday, please keep an eye on Teams for updates regarding your pick up times. These will be different from your normal pick up times.

For pupils sitting exams which end after the normal school day- Design and Manufacture Higher Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> May, **AH English Tuesday 7th May**, Spanish N5 **Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> May**, N5 **Biology Wednesday 15th May**, **ESOL Friday 24<sup>th</sup> May** and who are entitled to school transport, should ensure you returned the letter to the office for transport or have your Young Scot Card.

# NO EXAMS

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- If you have no exams you may be contacted to come in to complete unit assessments.
- The teacher who contacts you will arrange a specific time
- You will be expected to come in on the school bus in the morning.
- You **WILL BE EXPECTED** to participate in the Enrichment Programme. No exams or 1 exam = no study leave, therefore you will be in school learning!



Information about exams, Appeals etc will be uploaded to year group Teams and the school website before Results Day.

No other evidence will be submitted.

Your exam tolerance will be checked- your exam will not be remarked

# STUDY PROGRAMME GROUP 1 &2

You will have allocated times to come in and get support with your studying and revision.

Teachers will be on hand to help you with a study plan and technique.



# EXAM PREP CLASSES

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- All departments will have a drop in session ( detailed below). These will be published on Teams.

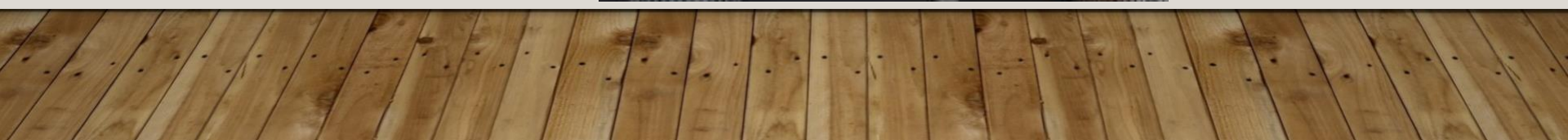
